Stormwater Department Monthly Report June 2022

Met with Yacht Drive resident and NC Coastal Federation on possible "Living Shoreline" project including across NW 19 Street end. The project consisted of building a bulkhead wall approximately 5 feet from the shoreline to reduce wave action and erosion on the shore. The project would cut off public access across Town property except for a 5-foot opening and would require a 10-year maintenance agreement for the structure (accessed from the water). After discussion with the Public Works Director and Stormwater it was recommended to the Town Manager to further discuss the potential project before a discussion to enter into an agreement at this time. The Town's decision not to enter into an agreement with the NC Coastal Federation at this time has no impact on the private homeowner's projects or cost-share rates. We continue to have issues with the 811 Utility Locate (call before you dig) system's lengthy timeframe between calling and actually being marked. We currently have approximately 15 unmarked locates that have been in the system for over 50 days. I continue to revise stormwater permit information on Development Service's website concerning requirements, worksheets, and fees. We are currently interviewing for 2 Equipment Operators in the Stormwater Department.
